

Objectives of the Course

By examining newspapers and magazines published during the Armistice and War of Independence periods, we aim to provide a more accurate assessment of the political climate of the period. Examining the attitudes of newspapers and magazines, which serve as sources for the period, toward the War of Independence contributes to a better understanding of the War of Independence.

Course Contents

The Turkish newspapers and magazines published in Türkiye from the Armistice of Mudros signed on October 30, 1918, until the Treaty of Lausanne and their attitudes towards the National Struggle movement are examined.
