## Objectives of the Course

In choir classes, students can: Acquire a choral culture related to the choral works they perform. They can perform assigned pieces accurately and beautifully as a group, while maintaining vocal health. By accuracy, students are expected to deliver their voices accurately and clearly, paying attention to the rhythm, tone, and pronunciation of the pieces. By beauty, they are expected to achieve homogeneity and evoke aesthetic pleasure in both the listener and themselves by paying attention to the harmony of the choir conductor.

**P.O. 2 :** Dizilerin oluşumu, üç ve dört sesli akorların kuruluşu, dizilerin armonizasyonu, kadanslar, ikincil dominantlar, vekil akorlar, gerilim sesleri, modal değişim akorları bilir.
