Objectives of the Course

Since the 1980s, changes in social, economic, technological, demographic, and international spheres have led to changes in local services and increased quality expectations, necessitating more professional and academic work by local governments. To achieve this, a significant reform movement has been initiated in the field of local government in Turkey. With the renewed legislation, the need for trained specialist personnel in this field has increased daily. Consequently, the need for local government programs has increased. One of the core courses in the program, "Local Governments," aims to train individuals who will enable local government units to produce more effective and efficient services.
