Objectives of the Course

The aim of the Commercial Law course is to enable students to understand the fundamental legal concepts, institutions, and principles governing commercial activities, and to analyze and apply the provisions related to commercial enterprises, merchants, and commercial companies in practice.

Course Contents

The Commercial Law course covers the fundamental concepts and institutions that form the legal framework of commercial activities. The course first addresses the sources of commercial law, the commercial enterprise, the merchant, commercial transactions, commercial provisions, and auxiliary persons of the merchant. It then examines, within the scope of company law, the concept and types of companies, the general provisions on commercial companies, and the formation, organs, shareholding structure, audit, and dissolution of joint stock and limited liability companies.
