This course aims to teach the economic, social, political and cultural dimensions of the life of cities in different socio-cultural and historical structures, to gain the ability to think critically on the social factors that cause urban structuring, the possible social effects of physical planning decisions, and the urban life and problems.

Course Contents

Definition of Sociology and Urban Sociology, research topics. Definitions of city, urbanization, urbanization. Emergence and development of cities. Formation of civilizations, social organization and urban society. Historical conditions of the development of cities, the role of political and religious organizations.
