Event participations that do not exceed 30 minutes will not be valid. □ Which events will be evaluated within the scope of “Scientific and Cultural Events” are determined by the “Scientific and Cultural Event Determination Committee” in accordance with the Nevşehir Hacı Bektaş Veli University Scientific and Cultural Events Course Directive and are published in the “Events” section on our University homepage. □ A maximum of 2 events per day are taken into account, provided that the hours do not overlap. □ Each event participation is evaluated for a maximum of 2 hours. □ Participations with only entry or only exit registrations are not evaluated. □ Library points will be entered by library counter staff. □ Entrance tickets purchased from different places will be valid for museum visits. Each museum visit will be considered as 1 hour. □ Each cinema will be considered as 1 hour. □ Students who do not complete the compulsory activities will be given an FD grade if they have participated in activities for 6 hours or more, and an FF grade if they have participated in less than 6 hours. □ Participation in activities will be made within the time period specified for courses in the academic calendar. □ There will be no midterm exam, final exam or make-up exam for this course. Exams for students who have completed the maximum time with a single course exam will be applied as homework or projects. □ When entering grades, the total hours specified in the information system at sistem.nevsehir.edu.tr will be entered without taking into account the decimal parts. □ Among the students who did not complete the compulsory activities, 6 hours are entered for those who participated in 6 or more activities, and the number of hours they participated in less. □ Within the scope of Article 12 of the Framework Regulation on Applied Training in Higher Education, activity limitations are applied as 2 times for the period in which they perform professional practice in the enterprise for students who receive education according to the vocational training model in the enterprise.
