General Info

Objectives of the Course

The aim of this course is to develop students' abilities to plan, conduct, and evaluate field research and community service practices in the field of social work; to enable them to experience the scientific research process through applied studies addressing a social problem; and to equip them with the skills to analyze and interpret quantitative and/or qualitative data obtained from the field using statistical methods. Within the scope of the course, students are expected to gain competencies in ethically appropriate data collection, project development through teamwork, and the design of social work interventions that are responsive to community needs.

Course Contents

This course focuses on the planning and implementation of field research and community service practices in the field of social work. Students learn through practice how to conduct research on a social issue, collect data in accordance with ethical principles, carry out fieldwork, and develop projects. The course also covers the statistical analysis and interpretation of collected data and the transfer of research findings into social work practice.
