Objectives of the Course

The aim of this course is to teach the fundamental principles and methods of designing and evaluating English Language Teaching (ELT) programs. Students will develop skills to critically evaluate ELT programs, apply various evaluation techniques, and analyze the strengths and weaknesses of existing programs. In addition, they will have the opportunity to connect theory with practice by reviewing evaluation studies conducted at both national and international levels.

Course Contents

This course covers the fundamental concepts, principles, and practices of evaluating English Language Teaching (ELT) programs. The topics include: Introduction to program evaluation and key concepts Principles of evaluation in ELT Practical evaluation techniques Evaluation of projects and programs Classroom observation methods The influence of political and personal dynamics on evaluation processes Review and presentation of research articles
