

Objectives of the Course

This course aims to equip prospective teachers with the ability to combine theoretical knowledge with practical applications in English language teaching. Students will learn to identify and elaborate on the parts of a lesson, develop curriculum and lesson plans, implement these plans, and improve their micro-teaching skills. The course is designed to help students acquire the competencies necessary to conduct effective and creative language teaching through a student-centered approach.

Course Contents

This course focuses on both theoretical and practical aspects of English language teaching. Students will gain knowledge in curriculum design, lesson planning, classroom management, teaching techniques, and material development. Micro-teaching activities will be conducted to practice teaching the core language skills such as listening, speaking, reading, writing, grammar, and vocabulary. The course also addresses technology-enhanced language teaching, interactive classroom practices, and assessment procedures.

Planned Learning Activities and Teaching Methods

This course aims to provide students with both theoretical knowledge and practical experience. The teaching process includes lectures, classroom discussions, group work, presentations, and micro-teaching sessions. Students actively participate in lesson planning, teaching techniques, and material development activities. In addition, technology-enhanced language teaching methods and interactive classroom practices are integrated into the course.
