
**PROCEDURES AND PRINCIPLES REGARDING THE
DETERMINATION OF THE STUDENTS RANKING IN THE FIRST
10% IN EVENING EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

In the sub clause (h) of the 46th article of the 2547 numbered Law amended by the article 173 of the Law numbered 6111;

“h. Except for the preparatory class, evening education students who are successful in the minimum courses determined for each semester in their department and who are in the top 10 percent of the ranking to be made at the end of the semester according to the average success of the students who take these courses, pay the tuition fee equal to the student contribution fee to be paid by the first education students in the next semester.

In this context, in determining the students who are in ten percent (10%) by taking the make-up exam results and the following points into consideration;

- 1- As stipulated in the aforementioned law articles, preparatory class students are not taken into consideration,
- 2- For a department, considering only the number of students enrolled in that department taking the minimum course for each semester (excluding Erasmus, exchange, special students, etc.)
- 3- In the calculation of the minimum course, the compulsory and elective courses determined by the Senate for the relevant term are taken into account, and the courses taken other than these are not taken into consideration,
- 4- The courses taken from the upper class in the relevant semester are not included in the number of required courses in the semester,
- 5- Students who are exempted from the courses they previously enrolled in the program they were enrolled in, and those who have the course they were exempted from in the relevant semester are not taken into consideration (except for the Foreign Language Exemption Exam organized by our university)
- 6- Students who have taken courses from previous semesters due to their unsuccessful courses and who have failed in any previous semester and students who have completed the maximum education period are not taken into consideration,
- 7- Assessment of students who have taken at least four (4) of the minimum courses in the relevant semester, (Success of all the minimum courses of the semester)
- 8- Taking into account the total number of students taking the minimum courses in the relevant semester in a department, if it is divided into groups (branch or class), it is not evaluated according to the groups, and the whole group is treated according to the total.
- 9- Students who have been subject to disciplinary punishment during their education and those who have registered to our University with a quota of foreign students are not taken into consideration,
- 10- The courses taken in the summer school are not included in the evaluation,
- 11- Evaluating other students who have the same academic average as the last student in the ten percent (10%) ranking,
- 12- It has been decided to implement these *Procedures and Principles* as of the 2019-2020 academic year.
